Purpose

ABTA Connections is an online community that connects patients, families and caregivers for support and inspiration. An ABTA Connections Monitor assists in making the community an inviting, supportive and helpful place for those impacted by a brain tumor. In addition to providing support, this role also monitors the community to ensure that all posts adhere to the Inspire Community Guidelines.

Volunteer Responsibilities

- Regularly respond to posts on Connections, with a priority on posts that have not yet received a reply
- Adhere to Inspire Community Guidelines
- Report any posts that do not adhere to the Community Guidelines directly to Inspire or to the Connections Program Manager

ABTA Support

- Provide meaningful opportunities for volunteers to make a difference
- Support volunteers with the trainings and resources needed to be successful

Training

- ABTA 101
- Brief phone orientation with Connections Program Manager

Helpful Attributes

- Belief in the importance of the mission of the ABTA
- Desire to make a difference in the lives of brain tumor patients and their families
- Positive personality with effective written communication skills
- Access to a device with internet capabilities

Time Commitment

An anticipated commitment of 1-5 hours/week for an initial 3 month trial period. After 3 months, the Connections Monitor and Connections Program Manager will discuss a possible longer term commitment.
